

The 26th Annual General Body Meeting of ISAPM started at 6:30pm in the seminar hall of College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Mannuthy, Thrissur (Kerala). Seventy five members of society were present in the said meeting, thus completing the quorum. Implementation of the decision of the last GB meeting was considered as appreciated.

1. It was decided by the house to organize 27th Annual Convention of ISAPM and National Conference at PGIVER, Jaipur (RAJUVAS). Date and duration will be decided by the organizing in accordance with President, ISAPM.
2. It was decided that, for holding national seminar/conferences, on demand by organizing secretary, an interest free start-up loan amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One lakh only) may be released from the society fund to initiate the works. The loan amount has to be returned to society positively within three months or latest by till the last day of conference without fail.
3. For the society awards (LTA and FNAPM), only the name of the awardees will be published publicly and not the mark list from next year onwards.
4. Society award (FNAPM) will be given to one third of the total applicants or minimum of 3 subjected the condition that they should be found qualified by the judges. In case of less than 3 candidates only, award will be given to all candidates based on judge's evaluation report.
5. Appreciation certificate must be given to the scientist of the society who has done exemplary work in the field of Livestock Production Management under general guidelines of the society for conservation and registration of new indigenous breeds.
6. Direct lifetime achievement award can be given to eminent scientists who have retired very early and have not been felicitated by FNAPM provided that he/she should be a life member of the society.
7. Registration fee for participation in national seminar/conferences for students will be enhanced to Rs. 2000 /- from next year onward.
8. Newly appointed associate chief editor and associate editor are requested to locate and encourage quality research papers and get them uploaded on IJAPM website in their respective regions and also help in reviewing and publication of the articles.

9. Full length papers of abstracts presented at ISAPM conference is to be uploaded by respective authors through the journals website subjected to the criteria that it should not be previously published anywhere else. Articles will be considered on priority basis for publication in the next issue subject to referee's approval.
10. Request for increasing the number of posters sessions and award will be studied and considered by the CEC.
11. Students, Assistant Professor and Associate Professor are to be promoted for presentation of abstract in different technical sessions. Senior Professors are requested not to compete for session awards.
12. For national LPM quiz competition, along with 2nd to Final year B.V.Sc.&A.H. students, MVSc (LPM) first years students will also be eligible take participate from coming year onward. Winners and runner up team will be awarded with certificates along with cash prizes of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) and Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand only), respectively. Cash prize will be given by organizing secretary, while certificated and trophy will be given by society.
13. National LPM quiz competition will be considered as a session of the conference/seminar and no any other technical session (oral/poster) will run parallel at the time of quiz competition. All the participants and team leaders from various universities will be given certificates of participation.
14. Quiz master and assistant quiz masters will be given certificates and mementos for their noteworthy contribution.
15. It was decided to initiate two following new awards for young scientists (below 30 years of age) who are not in service. Apart from appreciations certificate, a sum of Rs. 5000/- will be given to each winner by the ISAPM society.
 - a. Publisher of best article - Male (this will be from among those publishing a minimum of 2 research article in one year in IJAPM)
 - b. Publisher of best article - Female (this will be from among those publishing a minimum of 2 research article in one year in IJAPM)
