

**Proceedings of 3rd CEC meeting of
Indian Society of Animal Production & Management held at
College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry
Anand Agricultural University, Anand, Gujarat
(14-15 Sept, 2019)**

1. Meeting started with welcome of guests by Dr. K. N. Wadhvani, President, ISAPM, who was in the Chair.
2. The CEC accepted the previous 2nd CEC Meeting Proceedings as passed since there are no unresolved issues from the decisions of the same.
3. Dr. N S R Sastry, Patron, ISAPM discussed on strategies for conservation and improvement of indigenous breeds of cattle and buffalo via “Challenge Management”.
4. Dr. VIvek Patil, Member, CEC presented the procedure of Computerization - online registration system of ISAPM seminar/conferences as well as real-time Award decision making and presentation of recommendations. Suggestions were made by other members present in the house.
5. Dr. Sanjita Sharma, Member, CEC updated the house regarding upcoming ISAPM conference which is to be held from 4-6 February, 2019 at Jaipur. Members present in house suggested on different issues for better organization of national conference and 27th annual convention of ISAPM.
6. It was decided in the meeting that President, ISAPM will decide ISAPM young scientist award (Boys and Girls) in consultation with Chief Editor, IJAPM.
7. One or at the most two LTA award only will be given by the society. Apart from it one or two senior person from LPM may be honored by local organizing committee.
8. Name of Dr. N. S. R. Sastry will be sent by Society to Govt. of India for inclusion in Executive Committee of the central Animal Husbandry Ministry.
9. LTA and FNAPM award will be given to life members of LPM discipline only (MVSc & PhD in LPM).
10. ISAPM society and session awards will be given to life members only.
11. For attending national seminar / conference organized by ISAPM, membership of the Society is a must.
12. CEC members and ISAPM office bearers will be paid TA (3rd AC class of mail/express train excluding Rajdhani/Duronto trains) and DA (Fixed Rs.500/day) for attending CEC meeting/annual conventions of ISAPM.
13. It was decided in the meeting to felicitate LPM/Animal science scientists in forthcoming conference at Jaipur who registered livestock breeds over the last few years.
14. It was also decided to incorporate two region specific success stories of livestock keepers in seminar / conference compendium. Members may send good Success Stories from their Region, on these lines, to the OS of the Conference.

15. A thorough discussion was there on “Doubling of livestock keepers’ income by 2022” which will be submitted to Ministry of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fishery, GOI, New Delhi.
16. CEC unanimously decided to request Dr NSR Sastry to continue as Patron, despite his wish otherwise. Further, CEC decided, in view of his age, to pay Airfare to him and one additional person accompanying him for assistance.
17. In view of the present situation and internet position in Jammu and Kashmir, the likely alternative arrangements were discussed. Ultimately PVNRVASU, Hyderabad, next in the line to hold office and Gujarat were sounded. After hearing the views of the participants, Hyderabad delegation was given time to come up with a proposal in this regard.
18. CEC meeting ended with Vote of Thanks by Vice President(Central), ISAPM Dr. Aklank Jain.
